**DISCUSSION**

Discussion was held by Superintendent Royce and Principal Ellison to present on the draft of the elective teacher's job description for new job posting for OCS Hands-On Learning Pathway for secondary school. A breakdown of the skills and education topics were provided. Certifications needed for this position were included in the draft. R. Tessier inquired about grant opportunities. Discussion by J. Terakedis about FTEs and future planning for teachers needed.

R. Reynolds asked of the current status of the shop and any supplies that are feasible to repurpose. Current state of the shop and supplies cannot be used. R. Tessier asked administrators if the program is well supported. T. Comden comments that phase one with getting logistics figured out with middle school leads to success in high school. T. Comden emphasized the community business piece and relationship building from local businesses.

Comments from C. Garrison regarding first responders/medical field curriculum being added/included.

A. Ellison asks if seeking a candidate that fits 3-4 of the topics vs. finding someone that fits every certification that is listed. Discussion followed in flexibility to fit a candidate to job posting and certifications. The goal is to find a good teacher that can partner with the community to find specialists/guest instructors. J. Terakedis asks if this starts with 6th grade and moves toward other grades, or if offers to 6th, 7th, and 8th grades.
